The Intelligence Room of this organization is worthy of special note - situated near the Operations Office, it is readily available to all officers and interested enlisted personnel. The walls are lined with world maps - sections of territory on each - by which "up-to-the-minute" changes and progress are noted. Reading material of all kinds can be found on the book racks. Small pictures for the identification of aircraft are available for use. The room itself has several pieces of furniture, but the desk sits and absorbs the wealth of information in the room. A table serves well for orientation lectures - a screen is also present at one end so that training films may be shown without interruption.

Monday night when the various schools are not being operated, it offers the best opportunity to get the organization completely re-set up. On 24 October, 1943 (Sunday), an inspection of troops was held at 1800 on the flight ramp by the Group Commander. He then returned to the Group and presented a lecture on the importance of the state. On 25 October (Monday) he presented a lecture on the importance of the state. Sex morality lectures were scheduled for 31 October and 1 November. The articles of War were read. In presenting his sex morality lecture the Group Surgeon, Captain Dickson, employed several different and interesting methods. Certainly the purpose he intended the lecture to give will be remembered for a long time.

Friday, 29 October, 1943, at 1900 in the War Room, the Group Operations Officer, Major Logan, lectured the entire squadron on the importance of performing duties on time and correctly. He illustrated his talk in a most interesting manner by describing the coordination, functioning, and timing necessary in higher and lower echelons for the proper performance of assigned missions. An actual mission of which the Major had been a part in the bombing of Bremen, Germany, was outlined from beginning to end and the part each organization played in it. A few of the difficulties encountered in the past which assisted in planning subsequent activities were mentioned. In giving us an "over all" picture of expectations in doing the assigned task we departed with a determined understanding of doing our jobs a little bit better each day.

The Bureau of Public Relations of the Army Air Forces has commended Major Robert K. Morgan, Air Corps, as pilot of the Flying Fortress "Memphis Belle" and Staff Sergeant John P. Quinlan, 12036479, tail gunner. The crew performed 25 missions over France and Germany and were returned to the United States in June, 1943. Without leaves of absence, the crew of the "Memphis Belle" began a national tour to visit aircraft industry plants to relate employee's efforts directly to the air war, to stimulate Air Cadet recruiting, to help sell war bonds, and improve the morale to student air crews. A very heavy schedule of cross-country flights, public appearances, and meetings with military personnel, maintained with beneficial results of training, and for public and industrial relations, led to this commendation.
